February is American Heart Month. How appropriate since Valentine's Day is in February. A good time to show people you love that you appreciate them. Also a good time to show yourself some love by adopting some healthy habits. Kind of like New Year's resolutions in February. Heart disease is the Number 1 cause of death in the US for women. WEAR RED DAY IS FRIDAY, FEBRYARY 4th THIS YEAR.

Risk Factors for Heart Disease

Risk factors are conditions or habits that make a person more likely to develop a disease. They can also increase the chances that an existing disease will get

worse. Many of the risk factors that affect men also affect women. Important risk factors for heart disease are:

- Having high blood pressure
- Having high cholesterol
- <u>Unhealthy lifestyle</u>
- Being overweight or obese
- <u>Diabetes and prediabetes</u>
- <u>Smoking</u>
- Being physically inactive
- Having a family history of early heart disease
- Having a history of preeclampsia during pregnancy
- Unhealthy diet
- Age (55 or older for women)
