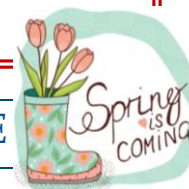

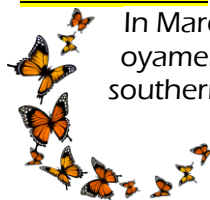

In March, the monarch butterflies that survived overwintering on the high altitude oyamel fir trees in Central Mexico will begin their journey northward into our southern states, nectaring, breeding and laying eggs on emerging milkweed.

Generation 1 of the 2020 population is thus started! Common milkweed seeds and accompanying information will be distributed at our meeting.

Each of us, as well as family and friends, can be part of the annual life cycle of this spectacular species by planting vital milkweed for Generations 3 and 4. (Joan)
