Conservation

How about this COLD weather! Here are some helpful ideas to save energy and still be warm and comfortable in your home this winter.

- 1. When you're at home and awake, set your thermostat as low as comfortable (suggested 68 degrees). Rather than turning up the thermostat if you're cold, put on an extra sweater or sweatshirt and cover with a blanket while you're reading or watching TV.
- 2. When you go to bed at night lower your thermostat (suggested 10-15 degrees). Wear warm jammies and socks. Add an extra blanket to your bed.
- 3. Make sure you know where your main water shut-off valve is located and how to shut it off. In this freezing weather, if a pipe bursts in your home, you can prevent a lot of damage being done. Also have the name/phone number of a plumber handy now so you won't waste time figuring out who to call should you have a problem.
- 4. While you're at home be active exercise, dance, do housework you might even work up a sweat!
- 5. Replace furnace filter once a month or as necessary.
- 6. If you have a central forced air heating unit, keep all doors to rooms and vents open so that the return air system works properly.
- 7. Turn on your room ceiling fans. Use the lowest speed and the blades should rotate clockwise. This will bring the rising warm air back down.
- 8. And most importantly for your safety, in this freezing cold weather don't go out unless it's absolutely necessary.
