Pill Bottle Recycling

Thanks to all of you who have cleaned and donated empty pill bottles. These are shipped to Africa so doctors don't have to wrap patients' pills in a piece of paper. Instead they can give

patients a clean container in which to carry their medicines home, which for some might be a mile or two walk. We collected 200 bottles in 2018 and have already collected 30 in 2019.

I know it's a pain to remove the labels but I have discovered something that has made the job easier. It's called Motsenbocker's Lift Off- Tape, Label, and Adhesive Remover (available on Amazon). I spray the label on the pill bottle and let it sit a long time- an hour or more. Then I peel off whatever I can and spray the label again and let it sit for a while. By then I usually can easily remove the rest of the label. Make sure you remove all of the label adhesive, and wash the bottle and cap in the dishwasher before bringing it to one of our meetings. Thanks for all of your efforts.
