  - Give your basket a clever name  
Some examples:
    - *Mexican Fiesta* (Chips, salsa, taco seasoning; tortillas, margarita glasses & ready mix);

- *Movie Night* ( Small electric popper, Popcorn bags or bowls, Popcorn seasoning, Popcorn, DVD, Movie theater certificate for tickets)
  - *Pamper Yourself* (Bubble bath, Bath sponge, Body lotions, Candle, Certificate to Bath & Body Works)
  - *Color Me Happy* (Coloring books, Colored pencils, Gel pens, Gift certificate to craft store)
  - List the items in your basket
  - State the value of your basket
  - Donated by: (Your name or all names who contributed). Include address if a non-member.

**Below are food guidelines:**

- Prepare food dish for 10–12 people
- Bring all food **READY TO SERVE**. Ovens will keep food warm before serving.

- Label your serving dish with your name
- **BRING A SERVING UTENSIL** and label it with your name.
- Be creative – Try to make your dish as **INTERNATIONAL** as possible!
