

★OFWC Information

Ohio Federation of Women's Clubs has a new website.

Martii and I saw the new OFWC website at the GFWC/OFWC Convention in April. If you want to access it, the URL is: http://www.gfwcohio.com/

You can access information on the first six tabs across the top. If you click on the "Clubs" tab you can see what other clubs around Ohio are doing.

However, if you want to access information in the "Member Clubs Directory" which also has copies of the various state forms that we use, you need to sign up. Do this as follows:

- Click on "Login/Sign up"
- Fill in your email, password and retype your password
- Click on "Go"
- If this is your first time, the information you just typed in will go to Maddie Crish, the Webmaster and she will compare your email to the one she has (from the information she has from our Yearbook). If she finds it, she will approve your access and you will receive an email confirming your registration. If access should be denied, let me know and I'll see what I can do.

Since Maddie isn't on the site all the time, this may take a number of days before you receive your confirmation. So if you think you will ever want to access member information or OFWC forms, sign up today.
