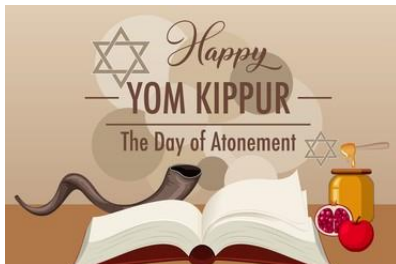
The deadline for Cuyahoga County and Lake County residents to register to vote in the November 8 General Election is October 11.
