## VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

To vote early in-person or on Election Day you'll need one of the following types of photo ID, which must be unexpired but does not require a current address.

- Any type of license or ID card issued by the Ohio Bureau of Motor vehicles. This can include a commercial, motorcycle, probationary, restricted, temporary, interim, or suspended license.
- An Ohio Bureau of Motor vehicles-issued state ID card
- A US passport book/card.
- US military ID card; Ohio National Guard ID card; or US Department of Veterans Affairs ID card.
