Accessory Exchange Rules:

- 1. Accessory items include: hats, barrettes or hair clips, jewelry, scarves and wraps (such as pashminas), purses, shoes, belts, bags (such as totes), gloves, new socks or stockings
- 2. You may bring up to 3 items for the exchange.
- 3. You will be given exchange tickets for each item that you brought to "buy" another item in the exchange.
- 4. Items will be arranged on tables of like items, such as a hat table, jewelry table, etc.
- 5. You can take your exchange tickets and place them on the item that you want.
- 6. At the end, if your ticket is the only one on that item, it is yours!
- 7. If 2 or more tickets are on the item, the bidding will start at \$1 and go up to \$1 increments. Highest bidder wins the item.
- 8. All left over items will be donated to Women's Safe.
- 9. Money raised will be donated to our General Fund.


